New York, NY (Tuesday, October 11, 2011) A fund in honor of Paula Ettelbrick has been established at the Stonewall Community Foundation. Paula, the immediate past Executive Director of Stonewall, died on October 7, 2011 after a year-long battle with cancer. The Paula Ettelbrick Memorial Fund shall be a grantmaking fund dedicated to the support of LGBTQ family programming and lesbian feminist issues.

As with all Stonewall grants, grantmaking decisions will be made by a community-based funding panel. Contributions to the fund are now being accepted and are fully tax-deductible.
