ABOUT THE 2009 STONEWALL SWIM

The 1st Annual Stonewall Swim is an athletic fundraiser for Stonewall Community Foundation, a philanthropic organization that supports a wide spectrum of LGBTQ groups. The event is benefiting the gay and lesbian community but everyone is encouraged to participate, women and men of all ages from every walk of life.

Date: Saturday, August 22, 2009 (foul weather date is Sunday, August 23, 2009)

Time: 9AM Check-in
10AM Launch

Fee: \$50 per swimmer

Requirements: All applicants must be at least 18 years old and completed 1 open water event or able to demonstrate ability for a 5K long distance swim.

Waiver and Release Form: See attached waiver/release form. It must be signed and accompanied with the application form to ensure processing. ***Applications without a signed waiver will not be accepted.***

Sponsorship Goals: While there are no sponsorship requirements, Stonewall encourages each participant to raise a minimum of \$1,500. Swimmers can collect pledges to meet their sponsorship goals via the Stonewall Swim Cause Page on Facebook or online at www.stonewallfoundation.org. Swimmers will be supported in fundraising by being assigned a Big Brother / Big Sister with an existing network of contacts.

How to register: Register online at www.stonewallfoundation.org or via mail or fax using this form. Fax and online registration close on Thursday, August 6, 2009. ***There will be no more than 30 swimmers.***

Course: The launch point is Browns River Road, Sayville NY and finishes at 517 Porgie Walk in Fire Island Pines. Please check www.stonewallfoundation.org for complete course information. Event will provide one kayaking guide for every two swimmer.

Transportation: Transportation to Sayville is either by car (see mapquest for directions) or on Long Island Railroad (see www.mta.info/lirr for schedules) and is the sole responsibility of the swim participants. Fire Island Ferry runs hourly for the return trip from the Pines to Sayville (see www.sayvilleferry.com for timetable).

Celebration: Please join us as we celebrate all the participants in this inaugural event at a finish line cocktail reception in the Pines (Fire Island, NY). Awards will be given to the swimmer who raised the most money and to the swimmer who recruited the most supporters.
